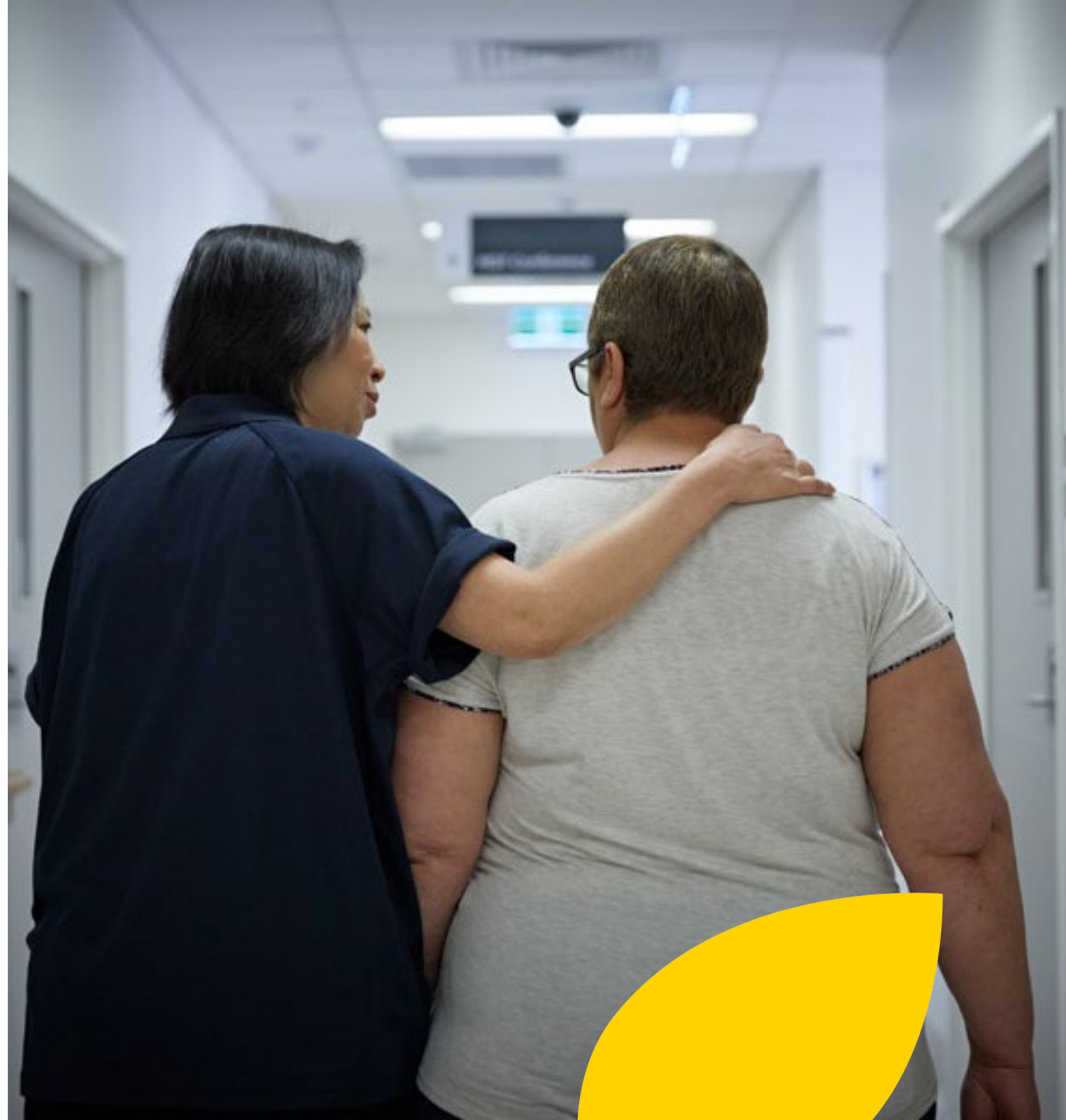

Priorities for the Plan

Cancer Prevention

- Reinforcing the NPHS:
 - reducing tobacco use
 - improving access to and the consumption of a healthy diet
 - increasing physical activity
 - influencing sun protective behaviour
 - reducing alcohol harm
 - raising awareness of modifiable risk factors
- Secondary prevention for people with cancer
 - smoking cessation
 - exercise

Cancer Screening & Early Detection

- Reinforcing the NPHS:
 - increasing cancer screening and prevention
 - improving immunisation coverage
- Full implementation of a National Lung Cancer Screening Program
- Build on Cancer Roadmaps and Action Plans

Optimal Cancer Treatment, Care & Support

- Address the financial burden of cancer
- National digital health and information strategy for cancer
- National oversight and implementation of optimal care pathways, clinical practice guidelines, and workforce planning

- Mature data system:
 - Data linkage
 - Health system performance reporting
 - Measuring optimal care
 - Public reporting

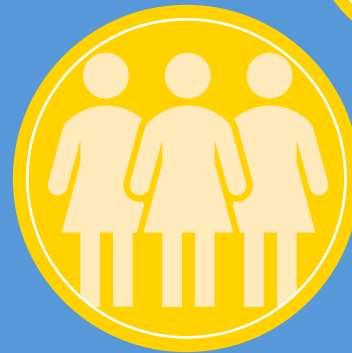
Cancer Research
