

Jeannie Ferris Cancer Australia Recognition Award

Award category descriptions

The Jeannie Ferris Cancer Australia Recognition Award recognises individuals who have made outstanding contributions to improving outcomes for women with gynaecological cancers in two categories:

► Category 1: Members of the community

Those with personal experience of gynaecological cancer, as a woman with a diagnosis of gynaecological cancer; a community or family member; or carers who have been directly involved in the support and care of a woman with gynaecological cancer.

► Category 2: Health professionals or researchers

Researchers and health professionals of all disciplines involved in gynaecological cancer research or clinical care, including (but not limited to) specialists, primary care practitioners, nursing and allied health professionals.

Compulsory eligibility criteria:

1. The nominee must be an Australian resident.
2. The nomination must include a short biography of the nominee (of no more than 500 words).
3. The nominee must give permission for the biographical details provided in the nomination to be used by Cancer Australia in any promotional material, should they be selected as an Awardee.
4. The nomination must include two written references that support the nominee's application.
