Strategy

...The Queensland project established six part-time SBN positions...

The Southern Zone was initially allocated funding by the Strengthening Support for Women with Breast Cancer Project for three part-time positions. In all three cases, however, due to management recognition of caseload issues and support for the role, extra funds were allocated by the respective Health Service District from the commencement of the project. This resulted in a 1.0 FTE for the Princess Alexandra Hospital, 0.4 FTE for the Gold Coast and 0.5 FTE for Toowoomba.

Key issues

- About 25% of women surveyed in Queensland would have preferred more regular scheduled appointments rather than the less structured approach taken in this project.
